8. To enhance the nature of placements by inviting more reputed companies offering better opportunities.

















IQAC meeting is held in the IQAC chamber on 29 – Jul – 2019 at 3:00 PM under the Chairmanship of Dr. S. Sambhu Prasad, Principal, Pragati Engineering College, Surampalem to discuss on the following agenda and to adopt resolutions.

Resolution – 1: A discussion has been made on the academic calendar prepared for the year 2019 – 20 and the members expressed their satisfaction. All HODs are requested to extend their support in implementing the academic calendar for the year 2019 – 20.

Resolution – 2: A discussion has been carried out by the members on the action plan submitted by the HODs of their departments for the year 2019 – 20. All the members expressed their satisfaction on the action plans and it is proposed to request all HODs to implement the action plans for the year 2019 – 20 for making a overall improvement of the department.

Resolution – 3: A discussion is made on the lesson plans and the learning notes prepared by the faculty and it is observed that learning notes and lesson plans are present with satisfactory standouts.

Resolution – 4: A review has been made on the coverage of syllabus by faculty for Mid – I examination for II, III and IV years and the syllabus coverage is satisfactory.

The result analysis of B.Tech., I Year– II Semester has been discussed on the basis of the results released. Total candidates appeared for I Year Examination = 937 and no. of candidates passed = 646, and the average percentage of pass of students is 68.94%. The individual department pass percent is

Resolution – 6: It is resolved to suggest all HODs of the departments to initiate various clubs / associations and forums with students participation to inculcate social responsibility among students.


