## Measures initiated by the Institution for the promotion of gender equity during the year

With institutions increasingly recognizing the importance of creating an environment that provides equal opportunities for all. PEC prioritized gender sensitization programs for faculty, staff, and students. PEC constituted Women Empowerment and Grievances Cell headed by the convener and represented by faculty and students from all the departments to address any related issues.

It is ensured that minimum one women faculty travels in every college bus to ascertain safe travel for the girl students. To encourage female students, PEC implemented various initiatives. These included establishing Special Prizes for girl students at Annual Day function and financial assistance programs especially for female students. The Institution creates awareness to all the girl students to apply for AICTE PRAGATI SCHOLARSHIP introduced for the benefit of girl students by the Government.
