Minutes of 25th Meeting of Governing Body

Item 1:

Welcome Address by Chairman, Governing Body

Dr. P.Krishna Rao, Chairman, Governing Body has extended warm welcome to honourable members of the Governing Body and delivered his welcome address. Honourable Chairman had briefly outlined some of the highlights after 24th Meeting of Governing Body.

- 1. Dr.Altaf Khan congratulated for the following achievements of the college,
 - a) Mechanical Engineering and Computer Science Engineering Departments are recognized as R&D Centres by JNTUK for the academic years 2018-19&2019-20.
 - b). i) The current batch placements stand at 410. TCS and Capgemini recruited 126 & 209 students respectively. More companies are expected to visit in secondsemester.
 - ii) A total of 558 placements were secured by 2015-19 passing out batch with highest CTC of 10 lakhs per annum and an avg CTC of 3.21 lakhs per annum.
 - c) Placement Day was celebrated on 16 March 2019. Ms. Naina Jaiswal, National and South Asian Champion in Table Tennis and Youngest girl in Asia to take her class X exam was the chief guest.

Note of appreciation to Training & Placement officer Mr. S.Vamsi Kiran and his team is given for good placements.

2. Dr. Vir Singh mentioned that the following achievement is a very good achievement and suggested to give incentive to the student.

"Mr. M. Rama Satyanarayana (of IV CSE) is selected as Alexa Student Influencer. He is one among 11 selections in the country and the only one from Andhra Pradesh. Alexa is a Amazon company".

- 6. More emphasis should be put on improving communication skills. External faculty should be invited for training sessions to improve the communication skills of students.
- 7. To improve technical writing skills and encourage the students to publishtechnical papers in international Journals.
- 8. Encourage the students to do more Internship at top institutions/industries. Internship should be clubbed with mini project.
- 9. Best students of EEE and ECE departments can apply for internship through Indian National Academy.
- 10. IIT BBSR encouraging students to do Internships. Encourage the students to dothe same.
- 11. GATE orientation classes should start from II year onwards and see that minimum 8-10% student should qualify in GATE Exam.
- 12. Perception level of students cannot be more than 20 minutes. Hencemonotonous lectures are to be avoided.
- 13. College should have MoU with application oriented companies. Outcome from MoUs to be documented. Dead MoUs are not to be listed.
- 14. Conduct Orientation program to faculty and students of ME Department to improve the results.
- 15. At least one International seminars/Conference/Workshop should be conducted.
- 16. Best Teacher award to be given gender wise on September 5th Teachers day orNovember 22nd National Education Day.
- 17. In academic council include outside members from CSE and EEE department also.
- 18. Retired engineers should be appointed for consultancy

- 19. Socially relevant projects to be encouraged.
- 20. As part of NSS activities, list of neighbouring villages and their respective problems/challenges can be prepared. After preparing need analysis on the same projects can be taken up by students.
- 21. Faculty cadre ratio should be maintained. More faculty with Ph.D. qualification should be employed.
- 22. More focus should be on the students having less attendance and preventive measures to be taken.
- 23. Identify the slow learners in B.Tech I year and remedial classes to be conducted.
