Minutes of sixth meeting of Academic council held on 16th February 2019.

Item 1:

Dr. S. Sambhu Prasad, Principal and Chairman Academic Council, Pragati Engineering college (Autonomous), Surampalem extended warm welcome to all the members of Academic council.

Item 2:

The members discussed and reviewed the resolution adopted in the V-Academic council meeting held on 12th Feb, 2018. The members after review made the following suggestions for implementation in respect to Agenda Point-

- i) The courses offered under MOOCs should be represented.
- ii) The students should be given freedom whether to take MOOCs course as optional and to consider credits to MOOCs course offered by NPTEL.
- iii) Proper justification should be recorded for including MOOCs in course structure.
- iv) The feedback from Alumni or Industry on the MOOCs courses opted/introduced by the students/Institution should be taken.

Item 3:

The members reviewed on the results and its analysis thoroughly and suggested the following

- i) The difference in the pass percentage of success should be presented by comparing the Autonomous Institution (Autonomous) result with JNTUK and also with the percentage results of surrounding Autonomous colleges if possible with proper justification.

Principal informed the members that it is difficult to get information about other autonomous colleges results.

- ii) Batch wise results should be graphically represented for comparative analysis with vertical alignment.
- iii) No. of distinctions, first classes, second class, pass class details to be represented along with failures also and the data should reflect admission category wise analysis also.
- iv) Subject wise results of college (autonomous) are to be compared with JNTUK and reasons for not obtaining 100% within the 1st supplementary exam results are to be presented.
- v) The action plan to be implemented for improving result should be presented.
- vi) The details of Moderation along with percentage and marks and the list of subjects eligible for moderation and justification is to be presented.
- vii) In calculation of graduation result the intake of each batch with success rate in 1st attempt and the details of students not appearing for the end examinations, and also the reasons for not clearing all the subjects within the period of graduation are to be presented.
- viii) The presentation of data should be in the form of Admitted/Registration - Appeared - Graduated reflecting distinction, 1st and 2nd classes.
- ix) focus to be made on 100% pass percentage in Mathematics and improvement of the results in Engineering /Applied Chemistry.
- x) In case of M.Tech courses comparison of results should be done for - two batches along with reasons for getting low pass percentage is to be mentioned.

Item 4:

After thorough discussion, the members of Academic council unanimously authorized the Principal of the college to represent the issue of readmission of Ms. Chameeru Deepika Roll No. 15A31A0464 in Pragati Engineering college in R16 Autonomous stream from R13 JNTUK stream with previous record to the concerned authorities of JNTUK, Kakinada for necessary and favorable action.

Item 5:

The members of Academic council unanimously announced their approval for organizing BOS meeting of all Departments and also extended their consent for applying for NBA accreditation in July 2019 and NAAC reaccreditation in December 2019 respectively.

Item 6:

The members of Academic council unanimously resolved to ratify the proposed list of members in BOS of all departments identified by college for designing the curriculum for R-19 regulations for the next 2 Academic years (2019-20 and 2020-21)

Item 7:

The Academic council members besides announcing their appreciation to the activities carried out in the institution by students/faculty suggested the following for implementation

- i) The activities of students/faculty are to be recorded in a period of every 6 months.
- ii) The external activities are to be classified into National and International wise.

Item 8:

The members reviewed R&D activities of the institution for the period 12th May 2019 to till date (16th February 2019)

Item 9:

The members of the Academic council reviewed on the Training and Placement activities of the institution.

Item 10:

Under any other item with the permission of the chair the following points are discussed.

(i) Differences observed in Autonomous and non Autonomous status:

The increase in result in autonomous stream is not very significant compared to the result under JNTUK, Kakinada. Discussion has been carried out on the issue and members from faculty presented their views that Autonomous status enhanced the work load in addition to routine academic activities and the Autonomous status can also help the institution to strengthen its over all development in infrastructure facilities and opportunities to extend linkages, MOU's and collaborations for institution industry interaction to develop skills in students for getting better opportunities in software/core industries in and around the state of Andhra Pradesh.

(ii) Involving faculty from Government Institutions in setting external Question Paper/Valuation.

The members suggested to utilize the expertise the faculty from Government Institutions/Universities

in setting external question paper/valuation.

(iii) Identification of latest courses in the market.

The members suggested to identify the best courses suitable for the local and market nodes in getting potential job opportunities.

(iv) Inviting Academic Council members to the Institution for interaction with students.

Hon'ble member of Academic Council, Sri Nagaryuna Malladi Life sciences - Tech Mahindra offered his readiness to visit the institution at times to interact with students. The members congratulated him.

(v) Result Analysis should be qualitative also.

The members suggested to include the analysis of results qualitatively in addition to quantitative analysis. Decimal values need not be shown in graphical representation.

(vi) Conduction of supplementary examinations.

The members suggested that supplementary examination can be conducted within the 10 days after announcement of the revaluation results.


(vii) Focus on enhancement in placements of Civil and Mechanical Engineering branches.


The members suggested to enhance the number of placements in civil and Mechanical Engineering branches.
