INTRODUCTION:

Mr. Sairam Satwik P, who is currently working as a Packaged App Developer Associate at Accenture, delivered an inspiring alumni talk for students. With one and a half years of corporate experience, Mr. Satwik shared his professional journey, starting from joining Accenture as his first company to working on SAP Concur and SAP Finance projects. In his current role as an Application Developer, he provided valuable insights into corporate life, project experiences, interview preparation, skill development, and the importance of certifications. He also addressed students' queries regarding placements, projects, and career growth in the IT industry.

QUESTION AND ANSWERS SESSION:

1. Q: How did you prepare for your placement interviews?

A: To prepare for placement interviews, I consistently practiced coding on platforms like LeetCode, HackerRank, and GeeksforGeeks, focusing especially on Data Structures and Algorithms (DSA). Alongside technical prep, I reviewed frequently asked HR questions to build confidence for behavioral interviews. I also dedicated time to revising core computer science subjects like DBMS, Operating Systems, and Computer Networks, which are commonly asked in technical rounds. Mock interviews and resume reviews were also part of my strategy to identify and improve weak areas.

2. Q: Which skills helped you the most in getting placed?

A: Several key skills contributed to my placement success. Firstly, strong problem-solving abilities through regular coding practice helped in cracking the technical rounds. Secondly, my communication skills were crucial during HR and group discussions, enabling me to express my thoughts clearly. Lastly, working on real-time projects gave me practical experience and the ability to demonstrate technical knowledge, teamwork, and initiative during interviews. These combined skills made a solid impression on recruiters.

3. Q: How important are internships during B.Tech?

A: Internships play a crucial role during B.Tech as they provide practical exposure to the corporate environment, tools, and technologies used in real projects. They also help in building industry-relevant skills, developing professional behavior, and networking with professionals. Having internships on your resume shows employers that you have hands-on experience, which often gives you an edge over other candidates during placements.

4. Q: Did you attend any online courses or certifications?

A: Yes, I enrolled in various online courses on platforms like Coursera, Udemy, and NPTEL. Some of the most beneficial ones were related to Python programming, Data Structures and Algorithms, and Web Development. These courses not only helped me strengthen my basics but also allowed me to explore advanced topics at my own pace. Adding certifications to my resume highlighted my dedication to learning beyond the classroom.

5. Q: How to handle rejection or failure during placements?

A: Facing rejection during placements can be tough, but it's important to understand that it's a part of the process. I learned to not take it personally and instead viewed each rejection as a learning opportunity. After every interview, I reflected on what went wrong and worked on improving it—be it technical skills or interview strategy. Staying consistent, positive, and open to feedback helped me overcome setbacks and stay motivated throughout the placement season.

6. Q: Any tips to balance academics and placement preparation?

A: Balancing academics and placements requires good time management. I created a daily schedule where I dedicated 1–2 hours each day to practice coding or revise technical concepts. I used weekends and holidays to work on projects, build my resume, or give mock interviews. Planning ahead for exams and prioritizing tasks helped me stay consistent with both academics and preparation without feeling overwhelmed.

CONCLUSION;


