1. **Entry Node (Guard Node)** → First server your request goes through.
2. **Middle Node(s)** → Passes the request further without revealing the original source.
3. **Exit Node** → The last node that connects you to the destination website.

- Access to Censored Content
- Secure Communication
- Access to .onion Websites
