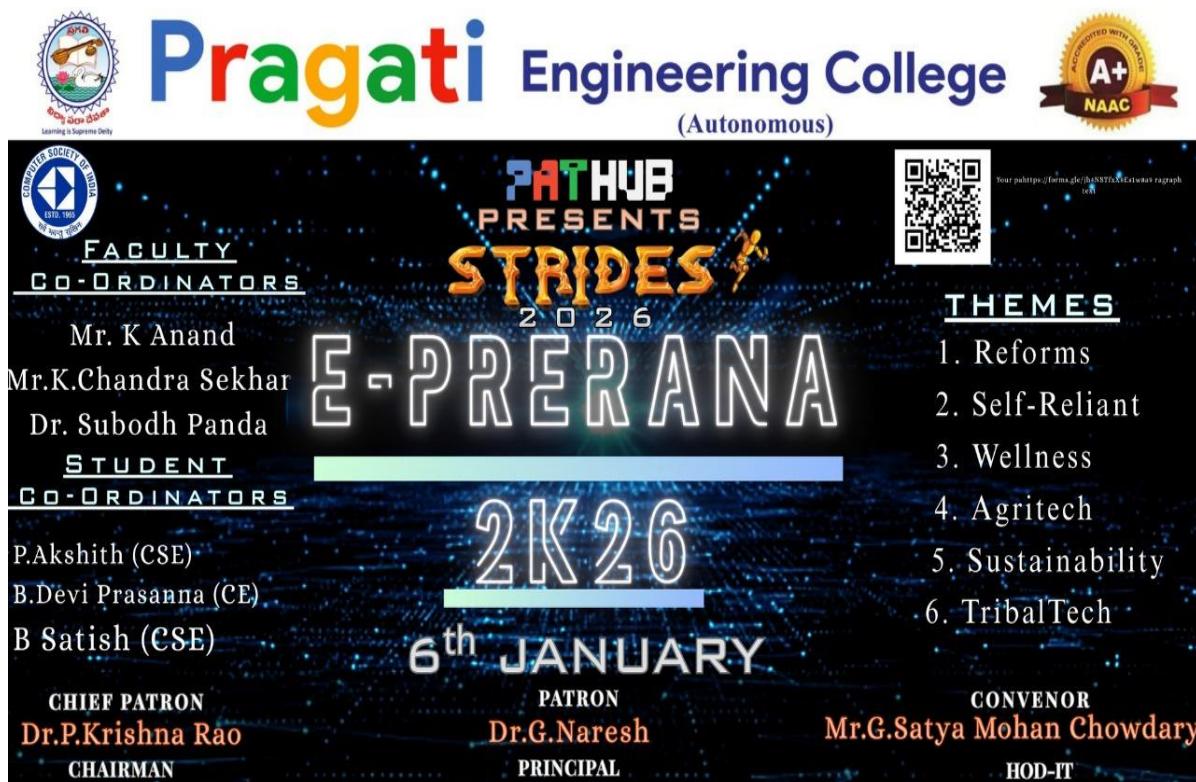


## About E-PRERANA 2K26

- A team can have a maximum of 3 members. The PPT should contain 6 to 7 slides only.
- Use bullet points for clarity and avoid lengthy paragraphs.
- Do not use animations or slide transitions and maintain a light-colored background with clear, readable text.
- Presentation time: 6 minutes per team. Question & Answer session: 2 minutes after the presentation.
- Ensure the topic is creative, well-researched, and technically sound.

**Outcome of the Event:** The event provided a valuable platform for students to enhance their entrepreneurial presentation skills and communication abilities. By developing and presenting venture ideas, participants gained confidence in expressing innovative concepts clearly. The activity promoted teamwork, analytical thinking, and creativity, encouraging students to identify real-world problems, propose feasible solutions, and present them professionally.
